

# OSPOID: Case Title

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- *ID: OSPOID*
- *Type: Qualified BOM of [Dev. Tools | Server | Client]*

In the specific compliance case file you should already have documented the software architecture of your system / product you want to distribute / sell compliantly. Now you must create the respective **qualified BOMs** (= Bill of Materials)

- **Creating a BOM** means: *For each component of your system create a list of all used open source applications and all embedded open source libraries / modules / snippets*
- **Creating a qualified BOM** means *For each entry of each **BOM** find and document the respective licensing statements by inserting into the respective line of the list*
  - a link to the respective homepage
  - the respective release number (helpful)
  - a typing as app (executed in its own address stack and talking with the other app only via inter process communication) or lib (being included or linked to the overarching component)
  - a link to the source code repository
  - a link to the respective license file or licensing statement
